'Wounded Sentiments: Religious Hate Speech and the Making of South Asian Secularism' – a talk by Dr. J. Barton Scott, Associate Professor, Historical Studies, University of Toronto, Canada discussed how the colonial history of secularism continues to influence contemporary global discussions through a deep dive into the history of Section 295A of Pakistan Penal Code which makes it a criminal offense to outrage religious feelings through insults to religion or religious belief.

The IBA-Dispute Resolution Forum hosted its inaugural seminar on 'Commercial, Corporate and Regulatory Mediation' at IBA's Islamabad Office. Hon'ble Justice Jawad Hassan, Judge at the Lahore High Court, gave the keynote address.
