Google I/O Extended 2024 at IBA Karachi: A Successful Tech Event





The Google I/O Extended 2024 at IBA Karachi attracted 1,447 participants, including 969 students. Dr. Shakeel A. Khoja, Dean SMCS, welcomed Googlers from Singapore and local guests, underscoring the importance of technology.

The event included 14 sessions on the latest Google technologies by industry leaders and seven workshops on AI, design, mobile development, and Women Techmakers. It also hosted the finals of a national startup competition.

Google Cloud and Tech Valley concluded the Startup Competition Pakistan 2024, with 700 submissions from over 70 cities. The Grand Finale at IBA showcased innovative solutions in Al, Fintech, Sustainability, Ecommerce, and Frontier Technologies.

Top VCs, including Indus Valley Capital and i2i Ventures, Sarmayacar, nVentures, and SEED Ventures, judged the event, awarding each track winner PKR 1 million and mentorship from Google experts. All 25 finalists received further mentorship opportunities from industry experts.
