
An interactive session led by skilled trainer and facilitator, Maisam Thariani, fostered collaboration and purpose as participants began their professional and personal growth journey.

IBA's HR Department has introduced key upgrades to our training framework to ensure programs are impactful and tailored to individual needs:

- Targeted Skill Assessment: Pre-training interviews and diagnostics help match content to participants' current skill levels.
- **Post-Training Evaluations:** Quizzes and assignments now assess knowledge retention and real-world application.
- Flexible Training Options: Employees may request relevant training sessions outside their TNA, within the approved limit, by contacting the L&OD team.
- **Digital Learning Tools:** All assessments and feedback are online, supporting sustainability and digital transformation goals.
- Supervisor Feedback Integration: Post-training input from line managers ensures learning is applied on the job effectively.

Serving Etiquettes for Support Staff



The HR department, in collaboration with Avari Towers, conducted a training session on Serving Etiquettes for six participants from IBA Karachi. This session built on a previous comprehensive training by the Avari team, which had significantly enhanced service standards for our support staff, including messengers and office boys. Key learning outcomes included: promptly addressing customer needs for efficient and professional service; best practices for serving meals with proper etiquette; maintaining hygiene to ensure safety and satisfaction; and appropriate manners during meetings to minimize disruptions.

Mastering Influencing & Negotiation Skills

IBA's HR department conducted a one-day workshop on 'Mastering Influencing & Negotiation Skills', facilitated by Dr. Usman Nazir. The session enhanced participants' communication through verbal, nonverbal, and active listening techniques. It deepened their understanding of ethical influence, persuasion, trust-building, organizational dynamics, negotiation models, BATNA (Best Alternative to a Negotiated Agreement), and negotiation phases. Interactive activities—including persuasion practice, problem-solving, and role-plays—enabled practical application of concepts in workplace scenarios. Pre- and post-assessments showed measurable improvement, with most participants earning certification.



MS Excel: Intermediate Level Workshop

The HR department, in collaboration with CICT, conducted a two-day Intermediate Excel workshop for IBA staff, facilitated by Syed Aftab Ahmed. The session began with a refresher on Excel basics and advanced topics such as data management, validation, and key functions, including logical, text, date, and lookup formulas—highlighting VLOOKUP, INDEX-MATCH, HLOOKUP, and XLOOKUP.

Participants practiced conditional formatting, tables, structured references, and Pivot Tables with charts and slicers. The session concluded with dashboard basics and formatting tips. Post-training assignments were evaluated on a Proficient–Developing–Emerging scale.



Building Bridges Through Communication

IBA's HR department held a one-day workshop for IBA staff, facilitated by Nadia Sayeed, focusing on effective communication skills. Topics included written structure, the 3Cs (Clear, Concise, Courteous), and overcoming barriers like fear and self-doubt. Participants explored personal communication styles, the PIE (Performance, Image, Exposure) and CAT (Context, Action, Thought) models, and practiced impactful speaking through interactive activities. The session received positive feedback for its practical relevance and engaging facilitation.
