## 'Innovation and Disruption: Business Success Through AI' - IBA-SBS 3rd International Conference 2024

The 3rd International Conference hosted by the School of Business Studies (SBS) on **'Innovation and Disruption: Business Success Through AI**' wraps up on a high note. Esteemed national and international academicians, researchers, practitioners, students and speakers participated in the conference.

Dr. S Akbar Zaidi, Executive Director, IBA delivered the opening remarks and welcomed the scholars to the two-day conference. He recognized the SBS for hosting its 3rd international conference on the pertinent topic of AI, emphasizing that Pakistan has a lot to work towards to catch up on the diverse effects of AI.

Dr. Irum Saba, Associate Professor, SBS, and Conference Convener, emphasized the uniqueness of this conference in bringing together academic scholars from Pakistan and around the world, along with industry practitioners.



A special thanks to our Guest of Honor, Dr. Tariq Rafi, Chairman, HEC Sindh, and Chief Guest, Mr. Qaiser Ahmed Sheikh, Federal Minister of Maritime Affairs, for their insights on how universities must harness AI for growth and survival. They emphasized the urgent need for Pakistan to catch up with global advancements in AI which is reshaping economies, societies, and education.

Our keynote speaker, Dr. Nora Ann Colton from UCL, who discussed the transformative potential of AI in healthcare and the reimagining of business education. Professor Geoffrey Wood from Western University, Canada, delved into the dual nature of AI technology, its calibration, and the hype versus reality debate. Dr. Adam Zaremba, from Montpellier Business School, and Poznań University of Economics and Business spoke on 'A Trend Factor for the Cross-section of Cryptocurrency Returns', discussing about CTREND, a new trend factor for cryptocurrency returns which aggregates price and volume information across various time horizons.

#### The Future of Dispute Resolution in Pakistan

The IBA in collaboration with the Singapore International Mediation Center (SIMC) and the Commercial Law Development Program (CLDP), U.S. Department of Commerce successfully hosted a seminar titled 'The Future of Dispute Resolution in Pakistan: Embracing the Singapore Convention on Mediation and Green ADR', at the National Institute of Banking and Finance (NIBAF) in Islamabad. The event brought together distinguished legal experts, climate change advocates, and key stakeholders to discuss the future of dispute resolution in Pakistan with a focus on mediation and sustainable practices.

Eric Ives, Attorney Advisor, CLDP, U.S. Department of Commerce, shared insights into the U.S. government's services and assistance to Pakistan's ADR movement. This was followed by an enlightening explanation of the Singapore Convention on Mediation by Sidharth Jha, Legal Counsel at the SIMC.

Amin Lakhani, Honorary Consulate General of Singapore in Pakistan, provided his perspective on the convention, and Dr. S Akbar Zaidi, Executive Director, IBA, highlighted the ADR initiative by IBA and expressed his commitment to future of ADR in Pakistan through the IBA ADR International Center (IBA ADRIC).

Chief Guest, Justice Syed Mansoor Ali Shah, Supreme Court of Pakistan, presented alarming statistics, revealing a staggering 2.4 million pending cases in Pakistan, mainly within the district judiciary, with 68,000 new cases filed monthly at the district level. Advocating for a paradigm shift, he proposed a sequence from negotiation to mediation to arbitration, positioning courts as the final recourse.

The second part of the seminar focused on 'Green ADR for Sustainability'. Syed Bulent Sohail, Attorney-Adviser to IBA ADRIC and SIMI Accredited Mediator, introduced the concept of Green ADR, emphasizing its core principles and environmental benefits.

Justice Jawad Hassan, Lahore High Court, highlighted in his conclusion note the pro-mediation stance of the superior judiciary. He stressed the urgent need for Pakistan to ratify the Singapore Convention, which already had provisions in implementation. Supporting his argument, he referenced numerous judgments. Milestone of the seminar was the signing of Memorandums of Understanding (MOUs) of IBA ADRIC with the Ministry of Law and Justice of Pakistan, the Directorate of Legal Education, Pakistan Bar Council, and the Islamabad Bar Council.







### SDGs Innovative Financing Challenge Cup's Capacity Building Workshop

IBA-CED, UNDP Pakistan and JS Bank launched the SDGs Innovative Financing Challenge Cup to encourage climate resilience and innovative climate financing in Pakistan.

The challenge opened doors for SMEs working innovatively and passionately for climate-sustainable solutions. Out of the 200+ SMEs that applied from more than 20 cities across Pakistan, 30 promising projects were shortlisted to participate in a two-day capacity building workshop at the Main Campus.

The two-day workshop featured esteemed speakers, including Dr. Lalarukh Ejaz, Director, IBA-CED; Umer Malik, Policy Analyst, UNDP; Jafar Raza, Group Head of Investment, International & Transactional Banking, JS Bank; and Rabia Khatak, Head, Diversity and Inclusion, Jazz.

The sessions covered a diverse range of topics including Innovative Leadership, Strategic Innovation, Scaling Business Models, Financial Strategies, Sustainability Integration, Intellectual Property Strategy, and Pitching for Growth.

The next phase of the Challenge Cup will identify the top 12 projects, which will then compete for further support and investment opportunities.

The panelists were Farhan Haroon, CEO and General Manager, Haleon Pakistan Limited, and M. Faisal Anwar, Chief Information Officer, MCB Bank Limited, moderated by SBS faculty member, Dr. Khalid Basit.

While Haroon gave examples of how their supply chain support system uses meteorological data to predict dynamic changes in demand, Anwar spoke of the importance of decision support systems (DSS) installed in banks to fight online fraud in real-time. They both spoke of applying critical thinking skills to use pertinent technologies to smoothen out relevant processes.
