IBA kicks-off EU funded cyber security ReCyP:HER project

March 25, 2021: The ReCyP:HER IBA team, comprising of faculty members from the Computer Science and SSLA departments, held a virtual meeting for the joint project. Funded by the European Union within the Erasmus+ programme, ReCyP:HER is a project designed to create a comprehensive capacity building in Pakistan in cybersecurity and psychology.

Other than the IBA, project partners include Erasmus+, Saarland University, Boğazisi University, LUMS, NUST and Air University. The event was attended by national and international participants as well as esteemed guests including Ambassador of the Federal Republic of Germany in Islamabad, Bernhard Schlagheck, Chairman, Higher Education Commission Pakistan, Dr. Tariq Banuri and Vice-Chancellors, Rectors and Presidents of partner universities. Addressing the audience, the speakers spoke about the significance of strengthening the cybersecurity environment in Pakistan.
